



REGISTRATION POLICY

All players must be registered and fees must be paid in FULL prior to stepping onto the ice (tryouts included).

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY : All players must qualify for registration in accordance to the OMHA Manual of Operations Player Eligibility Regulations. These regulations will be strictly enforced by EMHA and Registrations that do not qualify will not be accepted.*

GOALTENDER RELIEF : EMHA will strictly abide by the goaltender relief policy in accordance to OMHA Regulations.*

PROOF OF AGE : All **new** registrants to EMHA must provide a photocopy of their birth certificate or passport at the time of registration. Registrations will not be accepted without a copy of one of these certificates.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE : All players must be registered by the deadline as posted by EMHA and in accordance to the EMHA Payment & Refund Policy. Registrations received after the deadline may result in a player being placed on a waiting list should their respective division be at capacity.

REGISTRATION RATE: A registration fee schedule will be established annually by EMHA. The fee payable by each registrant will be in accordance to **the division rate** in which they will be playing for the current hockey season and according to the EMHA Payment & Refund Policy.

CODE OF CONDUCT: As a means of providing a positive environment within our minor hockey association, EMHA has adopted a Code of Conduct in which all members are expected to adhere to. **Each** parent/guardian is required to submit a signed copy at the time of registration or complete during online registration. Registration will not be accepted without a signed copy (either electronic or hard copy).

PERMISSION TO SKATE/ PASSPORT : All requests made after **July 1st** for a 'Permission to Skate/Passport' document must be made in writing, to the attention of the OMHA Representative. Please allow 72 hours for processing. To secure a position on a team within EMHA and be eligible for tryouts, a completed registration form and a cheque for the registration fee must be submitted to the Registrar prior to the registration deadline. These will be held on file pending the outcome of the tryouts with the other Centre. Should a player's endeavour be successful, both the registration form and cheque will be available for pick up or be destroyed at the player's request.

VERBAL REGISTRATION : No verbal registration(s) will be accepted by EMHA.

OUTSTANDING FEES : Any outstanding balances owed to EMHA must be paid in full prior to registration being accepted for the current year.

DIVISION OF REGISTRANT : All players must register in their appropriate division according to their age on Dec 31st of that registration year.

FEES: Registration fees for returning members will increase by \$100 on July 1 of the current year.

RESPECT IN SPORT: One parent/guardian must complete the mandatory online program – OMHA Respect in Sport for Parents. All EMHA participants must be added to the Respect in Sport account. The EMHA registrar should be notified upon completion.
